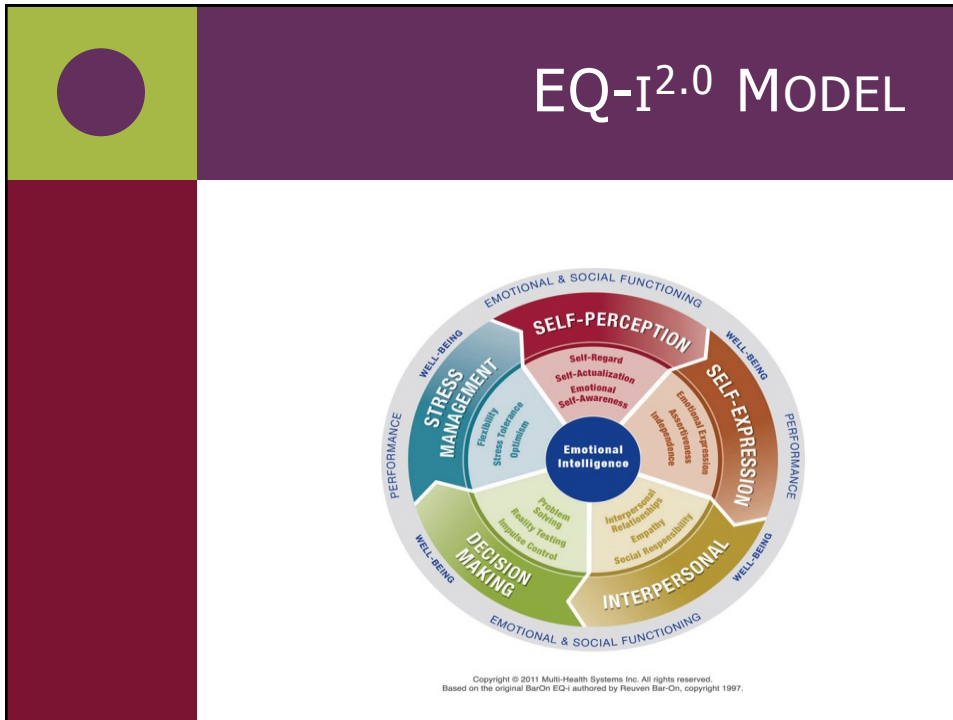
Seeking a innovative approach to help others understand their EQ-i^{2.0}?
